Ways to Vote:

1. Election Day Voting

On Election Day, you must vote at the polling place that is assigned to your precinct and your ballot will be there waiting for you. Florida Law requires all voters to provide a valid photo and signature ID before you can vote. Polls are open 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.

2. Vote-By-Mail

Vote-by-mail refers to voting a ballot received by mail or picked up by or for a voter instead of going to the polls to vote during early voting or election day. Any registered voter can vote by mail. Be sure to sign the return envelope! Don't want to mail your Vote-by-Mail ballot? Drop it off at one of the Early Voting locations during early voting hours in the secure box provided.

3. Early Voting

Early Voting allows you the opportunity to cast your vote before the general election. Locations are chosen with the voter in mind, while remaining in compliance with Florida law. Any eligible registered voter in Palm Beach County is able to vote at early voting sites when open. Bring two forms of valid and current identification that include your signature and photo.
