Gemilut Hasadim, which translates to “the giving of loving-kindness,” is a fundamental social value in the everyday lives of Jews. It is a commandment (mitzvah) that an individual completes gemilut hasadim without the anticipation of receiving something in return. It is my belief that everyday acts of loving-kindness are as important as daily prayer. In my opinion, our relationship with God— our spiritual practice — is directly correlated with our behavior towards other human beings.

Volunteering as TSS’s Social Action Committee Chair has afforded me the opportunity to make my Judaism more relevant and impactful.
