

RABBI'S FORUM

Rabbi Anthony Fratello

I had the opportunity recently to participate in the Conversion of a young person into the Jewish Faith. This is at once the most exhilarating experience and also the most terrifying. It is exhilarating to be in the presence of someone who has chosen Judaism (more on that below), but it is daunting. It is frightening to think that this person's ideas about Judaism, their conceptions, their conceits, what they believe and how they believe it; are all informed and shaped by what I chose to do. I fear sometimes that I am not adequately up to the task.

Most of you know that my father (z"l) was a Jew by Choice. His experiences impacted me greatly; there are countless things I do in my professional life that are shaped in many ways by his journey to Judaism. Most of us, or I should say, many of us, forget how amazing our culture and traditions are. We are born into a world of Shabbat, and the various customs that make it special. We are born into an understanding of God and the Covenant. We are born into knowledge that our questions are good and welcome. We are born into the culture that makes Jewish Life the rich endeavor that it is. Because of that familiarity, we tend to forget how dear and precious it is. What is the old expression? Familiarity breeds content! Sometimes, sometimes...

That is part of what makes working with Conversion Candidates so very rewarding. They do not come into this with preconceptions, or I should say their preconceptions are based on prior religious experience. How many times have Jews by Choice told me, "Rabbi, Shabbat is such an amazing experience." How many times have they been grateful to find themselves in a community that not only engenders the asking of questions, but turns it into a worthwhile activity? How many times have they said to me, "Rabbi... the God I learned of when growing up was judgmental and ever critical. The concept of God I have found in Judaism is a God of tolerance and love. How grateful, Rabbi, that our lives are governed NOT by what we believe, but rather by what we do."

We are taught these things, but then forget them, or consign them to parts of our brains that we rarely access, or simply take them for granted. Our Congregation is filled with people who have chosen Judaism for their lives. Chances are you have met them, sat next to them, perhaps even spoken to them at the Oneg. God bless. Take a moment and look at the world through THEIR Jewish eyes. Strive to see it not as you have always accepted it to be, but rather by what you have CHOSEN it to be.

After all, we are the Chosen People.



From the Board Room

January 2023

Our Board Meeting was on ZOOM and at 6pm to permit time for the Cantor Search Committee to continue its deliberations. We have received several applications for the Cantor position. The Committee is reviewing each candidate's application, prior to a ZOOM interview.

The next step is to listen to the Cantor-candidate sing/chant. Those who qualify will be invited to TSS for a multi-day visit, including a small recital. Cantor-candidates are not permitted to participate in a service at interviewing temples. The Cantor Search Committee will make its recommendation to the Board and the Board will negotiate an offer. The Board will then recommend the candidate to the congregation for its vote of approval.

A Nominating Committee has been established consisting of Board Members and Congregants.

This year there will be five Trustee positions to be filled and three Officers positions.

The Board meets once a month on the third Tuesday at 7pm. In addition to the monthly Board Meeting, each Member serves on a committee of his/her choice. A diverse Board membership permits the full range of congregant's concerns to be met. The Constitution states:

The Board of Trustees shall have full power, authority, and responsibility to conduct the administration and business of the Congregation, establish operating policy, manage its property and revenue, and take such action as it shall deem best to promote the welfare of the Congregation. Only a person who is Jewish, who practices Judaism to the exclusion of other faiths, upholds the Jewish faith, and is a member in good standing, can serve as an Officer or Trustee of the Temple. Unless otherwise stated, all votes of the Board shall be by simple majority.

Officers are elected for a two-year term. Trustees shall be elected for a three-year term.

Please consider serving on the Board. Of course, it is an honor to be on the Board, but more importantly, it provides the congregation with your experience and your vision for TSS.

We all know that data shows temples are serving many different needs today. Only with a Board that represents these needs, can we fashion the TSS that will serve us in the ways we want and need.


