By now you have heard the news that we have engaged a new Cantor. I am so very glad that Cantor Carrie Barry will begin with us July 1!

It was obvious speaking with candidates while we were interviewing, that they looked at us as closely as we looked at them. Several commented on parts of our worship that they found interesting, in particular Nachas News. One said, "It is so neat that you do that!" Agreed, only I cannot take ANY credit for it. Nachas News was the brainchild of Rabbi Sam Jaffe, who was the Founding Rabbi of Temple Shaarei Shalom. When I first interviewed and later started they said to me, "Oh... hey... we do this thing during Services, and the rest is history."

There are some people in the Congregation who are not big fans of Nachas News, and others who say it is part of why they come every week. Far too often we hear only the bad things that are happening; and do not spend enough time looking for, or celebrating, the good news. Indeed, we need more good news in our lives.

Over the years, Nachas News has gone through any number of iterations. None of us are soon to forget the tales that Abe Bressler (z"l) used to share with us. I will tell you over the years that there have been times when I had to pull people aside and speak with them about their News. We can print it up in the Blue Sheets (the Sabbath Inserts) or I will give it a shout out from the Bema. Let's do that; I am happy to do that. And let's keep Nachas News as the time to share what is happening in our hearts.

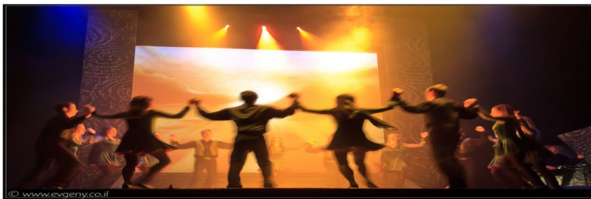
