RABBI'S FORUM

Well... it is summer. For us in Florida we know that that means hot, buggy days, and sweltering nights. But it also means time at the beach and time with our family. School's out, our schedules have a little slack, and we can find some time to rest and recuperate. God bless it!

For many of the young people in our community, summer can be summed up in one word: CAMP! Whether it is Day Camp or Sleep Away Camp, whether it is here in Florida, or in other places around the country, youngsters from our community either have, or soon will, head off for a summer of adventure.

Those who study North American Jewry will tell you that the Camping Movement has had the greatest success of any of our endeavors as a community. It is at camp that our young people form their tightest bonds, most successfully develop their own Jewish Identity, and come into the closest contact with other members of our faith. The money and effort that has gone into promoting Jewish Camping has paid great dividends. In return, the Camp Movement have nurtured our own discrete communities. So much of our worship and our styles of practice had their origins around campfires, or in the dining halls after

meals. For instance, without camp, it is unlikely that the music of Debbie Friedman would ever have achieved the iconic place that it has in our Worship.

Part of this success is due to the very nature of camp. A camp community is a deliberate community. Its members have worked (and many times saved) to attend. The constituency is there because it WANTS to be there. That deliberate quality is part and parcel of what makes it so successful. That deliberate quality is part and parcel of what makes camp so special.

I would like to suggest that we take a moment to apply some of that same zest to the other communities that we inhabit. Many of us live in gated communities. These too are deliberate communities. Most of you reading these words are members of TSS. That is most certainly a deliberate community. We have come together as Jews to try to live our lives in concert with one another and with the values and rhythms of our people. Do not take that for granted. Who knows? If we put as much effort and joy into this community, maybe we too will come out singing the same songs.

Education Update

The Torah teaches, “Tzedek, tzedek tirdof – justice, justice shall you pursue.” Last year, Last December, three of our teens had the extraordinary opportunity to attend L’taken, a four-day Jewish social justice trip in Washington, D.C. I am excited to announce that we will participate again this year, on January 19-22, 2024.

The L’Taken Social Justice Seminar is for high school students from across the country, run by the Religious Action Center, the Reform movement’s hub of Social Justice work in Washington D.C. They will celebrate Shabbat, visit historic sites, receive advocacy training, and explore issues of social justice and Reform Jewish responses to them. The teens will have an opportunity to explore an issue they are enthusiastic about and spend a day on Capitol Hill lobbying our Senators and Representatives. It is a highlight of their Jewish learning and an experience so inspiring, that past participants often return for a second time.

Last year’s participants lobbied for teen mental health awareness. They met with representatives from Representative Lois Frankel’s office and members of Senator Marco Rubio’s staff. Here is what our participants from the 2022 Confirmation class had to say about their experiences:

Lola, an 11th Grader at Olympic Heights said: “L’taken allowed me to gain different perspectives on life and voice my opinion to officials with high authority; being able to speak for our youth and represent my religion in Congress felt incredible. “

Jacob, an 11th Grader at Park Vista exclaimed: “It felt amazing to be able to not only lobby in Congress but also to meet people from all over the country!”

Brooke, an 11th Grader at Park Vista explained: “I was able to make a difference in an important issue, and that feeling was truly incredible.

Next school year, our delegation will be traveling to Washington D.C. Friday, January 19 – Monday January 22, 2023. Any 10th – 12th grader that is enrolled or has completed our Confirmation program is eligible to attend. This is an excused absence from school and is a wonderful addition to resume booster. Thanks to some very generous endowments, we can provide significant financial assistance to our participants. However, if you are interested in supporting this important educational experience, please donate to one of the TSS funds that support teen education.

Take Me Out to the Ball Park: In Israel

It is summertime and in the United States, which means it is time for baseball. Surprisingly, our American pastime is becoming increasingly popular in Israel.

A bit of history:

Baseball was first played in British Mandatory Palestine on July 4, 1927, an appropriate date for this very American sport. In 1979, the first field was built in Kibbutz Gezer, a kibbutz founded by Americans. Israel now has a baseball field at the Yarkon Sports Complex in Petach Tikva.

The Israel Association of Baseball (IAB) was established in 1986 to promote the sport through teaching baseball to youth, organizing national tournaments, and assisting Israeli teams to compete internationally.

Notable players from the IAB include Alon Leichman and Dean Kremer:

Leichman is now the Cincinnati Reds' assistant pitching coach. He has come a long way from growing up on Kibbutz Gezer and playing baseball on a small sandlot field where the bases rested on the outfield grass. It was about 250 feet from home plate to center field. Beyond the perimeter of the baseball field, stood a large sunflower field. Leichman commented in an interview, "Outside of this 250-person community, no one knew what baseball was, pretty much. Every time anyone heard about me playing baseball, the reaction was, 'What?' They weren't sure of the difference between football and baseball."

Dean Kremer is an Israeli American professional baseball pitcher for the Baltimore Orioles. In 2015 he became the first Israeli drafted by an MLB team and made his MLB debut in September 2020. **Kremer was clearly the Orioles' premier pitcher in 2022.** His 3.23 ERA, 124 ERA+, and 3.80 FIP were all the best marks on the team among hurlers with at least 100 innings pitched.

Israel Baseball Academy:

Under the authority of the IAB, the Israel Baseball Academy launched in October 2014. Academy players participate in weekly training that gives them opportunities to play in the Israel National Team Program and to be recognized as Elite Athletes in the IDF. The program is also recognized by Major League Baseball and will give them access to programs designed for the best young players in Europe.

SUCCESS:

Israeli teams have had some success in the World Baseball Classic and the Olympics. If you would like to "see" them in action, check out these films on your streaming service: "**Heading Home: The Tale of Team Israel**" and "**Israel Swings for Gold.**"

The next time you are in Israel, attend a game and sing, "Buy me some falafel and hummus...Just root, root, root for Team Israel."

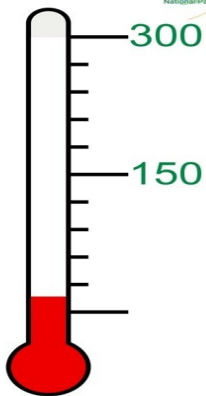
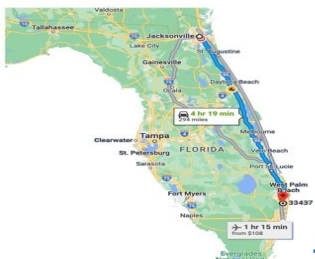
