RABBI'S FORUM

Rabbi Anthony Fratello, MAHL

I received an Email recently from a former member of Temple Shaarei Shalom. This person was planning to relocate out of the area and as they were busy packing came across a number of older Jewish Books. I am sure MOST of you, have that one place in your house—that one shelf, that one spot on a credenza or a side table—where the Jewish Books go. Like you, this person had a couple of old prayerbooks, gifted to him by one deceased relative or another. A few books on Jewish History. And maybe a TaNaKh or Chumash thrown in for good measure. This person wanted to keep some of these books—they were usable, they were in good condition, they had lasting sentimental value. Others were showing their wear and tear—cracked bindings, doubtful utility.

And THAT, was the reason for the Email. “Rabbi... what do I do with these books?”

The quick answer is one that many of you probably know. When a prayerbook is no longer usable, or any ritual object for that matter, we are not supposed to just throw them away. Tradition says to bury them. As an aside, I keep a box under my desk in my office for Shemot, as they are called. And every so often I take a bag or two to the cemetery, and they are buried in hallowed ground.

The more significant answer is ALSO one that you know, though you do not know that you know it.

Many people today do not know enough about their Jewish Heritage. If I sound preachy, it is because I mean to sound preachy. Too many of us do not understand the basics of our tradition, and I, along with the Cantor and Lisa, in fact almost everyone at Temple, try to encourage you to learn more and understand more about our heritage and history. But there are some lessons, some ideas, that are so ingrained, you know the answer whether you realize it or not. “Oh... this is a Jewish Book that is no longer usable. I do not know what it is about. I do not recognize the language it was written in. I am not even sure where I got it from in the first place. But I do know that I must find the RIGHT way to dispose of it.”

It is hard to know where to begin sometimes with our journey of knowledge. Or even if we know how to begin, sometimes it is hard to get started. Let me suggest a place: Reverence for the written word. Our people have survived

throughout the centuries, indeed our people have thrived throughout the centuries because of our reverence for the written word. When our ancestors were driven from their homes, it was their books and their ideas that they brought with them. Did I wish that more people understood more about Judaism, YES, yes, I do! But it is enough to be satisfied with reverence for the written word.

Let's start there.

Education Update

I just returned from escorting a group of 60 rising 11th graders on a URJ Yallah/NFTY trip to Poland and Israel. All along this journey, I kept thinking about why Jewish education is so important, and how could I be sure that all of my students might one day get to experience a trip like this. And how can we offer meaningful Jewish educational experiences to our members, from the tots to the seniors?

There are many goals for Jewish education. It helps to give access to the Torah and Rabbinic resources that explain our tradition. This understanding can add meaning to our lives, help us to navigate complicated situations, and enrich our family experiences. It is also a way for us to become part of the community, to learn timeless Jewish values, and to be part of the Klal Yisrael, Jewish peoplehood.

Recent studies have talked about why parents want a Jewish education for their children. Although many people assume it is for Bar/Bat Mitzvah, this is NOT what parents say. Rather, they state: "I want my child to feel connected to his community", or, "so my child has a safe space where they are embraced, accepted, and encouraged to be their authentic self", and "to understand what it means to be a mensch (a good person) and how to help make the world a better place." These are the goals of our program here at TSS.

The backbone of our program is from the Shalom Learning curriculum. It is an interactive, values-based curriculum that helps children develop a positive Jewish identity. Through the use of videos, text, and prayer students examine these values through different lenses in each grade. Younger students experience lessons that emphasize the five senses, though art and STEM projects. In grades 3 - 7, Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) skills are incorporated that enable students to build positive relationships and make responsible decisions. Through the values, students explore Jewish text, Torah, history, prayers, holidays, and the land of Israel.

In each grade, there is also a focus on Hebrew language. All students are introduced to Hebrew vocabulary on a weekly basis, and we sing and pray together in the Sanctuary. Grades K-3 also have a class where students learn Hebrew through movement and games. In 4th grade, students begin formal instruction which includes Hebrew decoding and reading the prayers. Students' progress at their own pace with private or small group instruction. Prayers are reviewed weekly in Kehillah and in class.

Holiday celebrations often take the form of whole school programs which often involve parents too! This year, we will be offering some specific learning opportunities for the adults while the students are in class on Sunday mornings. Please watch for updates and information.

For students in 8th - 12th grades, Our Teen/Tichon program offers students a safe space to share and discover. They continue to build their Jewish identities by examining the world through Jewish values. They hone their critical thinking skills by reading texts and learn to advocate for themselves and others by discussing these texts. They create bonds between themselves, in and out of class through fun and social activities, and to the Jewish community by working on mitzvah projects.

Students in all grades study Israel, from ancient history to modern technology. Some of our classes are involved in Partnerships with Israeli classes from the Tzohar region, through a program with the Jewish Federation. We also work with our local Shaliach/emissary, and this year will have visits from one of the Israeli Shinshinim (young emissaries).

I am excited for the new year 5784! School begins on SUNDAY, 8/20/23 with a Pancake Breakfast for TSSRS students and Families. If you have any questions or have friends that might be interested in our program, please have them contact me! tssrs@templeshaareishalom.com or 561-364-9054 ext. 107
