Temple Shaarei Shalom Programs & Activities Descriptions

Committees:

Ambassadors: Connect Temple Members (Ambassadors) with New Members to help those new members to be integrated into the Temple community.

Caring Committee: Will help and support each of our members as we experience the events, stages, and transitions of life.

Education Committee: working in partnership with the Director of Lifelong Learning and the Rabbi, develops education policies that reflect a commitment to Lifelong Learning. It will consist of two subcommittees: one dealing with Religious School and one dealing with Adult Education.

Family Engagement Committee: The Goal is assisting families and students in getting to know one another, and to shine a light on all opportunities for students and families to get involved.

Israel Programming Committee: Work with Israel Committee to develop & facilitate Israel focused programs.

Legacy Committee: Is responsible for developing and implementing the Endowment Development Program. The Committee will provide structure and the process designed to stimulate interest in the program.

Membership Recruitment Committee: Works to develop programs for recruiting and welcoming new members and for integrating and retaining current members.

Membership Retention Committee: Works to develop programs for retaining current members.

Ritual Committee: Works with the Ritual Chair and assists Clergy with all aspects of services and religious rituals, assigning honors, assisting with Minyans.

Security/Building Committee: Works to make Security Policies and renew and update building structure.

Social Action Committee: Serves as a liaison between the Temple and community on all matters of social action and social justice.

High Holy Day Ushering Committee: Usher during Shabbat and High Holy Days.

Auxiliaries:

Brotherhood (Auxiliary): Men who are working and those who are retired, focus on social events, social action, religious-based activities for this group and fundraising for the Temple.

PTO (Parent-Teacher Organization): Works with the President of PTO. Supports the religious school.

Sisterhood: Sponsors Judaica Shop; monthly luncheon programs; supports Temple activities, sponsors HHD quartet and makes significant donation to Sisterhood Scholarship Fund.

Youth Groups: Three Youth groups, 'Lil STARY for 4th & 5th grade, STARY Jr. for grades 6th & 7th and STARY for grades 8-12, provide opportunities for social, religious and educational experiences for our Temple youth.

Havurot/Affinity Groups

are social groups where TSS members get together with a other members sharing a common interest. These groups usually are self-sufficient and are for members only (sometimes include guests) and can meet at their own discretion.
